DR. SANDRA MODISETT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

Dr. Sandra Modisett: A Leader in the '90s

The woman for which the Sandra Modisett Memorial Scholarship is named was an influential professional in the field of parks and recreation in North Dakota.

Dr. "Sandy" Modisett was a professor of recreation at the University of North Dakota in Grand Forks, president of the North Dakota Recreation & Park Association (NDRPA) and vice chairperson for the Grand Forks Park District. She was elected president of the park board May 1, 1990. She was also an active member of the St. Paul's Episcopal Church. Modisett died of natural causes May 7, 1990, in her home.

Born in Minneapolis, Minn., Modisett moved to Dickinson, N.D., with her family when she was in junior high. She graduated from Dickinson Central High School in 1953 and Dickinson State College in 1956. In 1958, she went to Europe to teach in American high schools in France and Germany. She moved to Grand Forks in 1978 where she directed the recreation division of UND's Health, Physical Education and Recreation Department.

Modisett's family and colleagues remember her for her enthusiasm, warmth and adventurous nature. "She was the kind of person who really took hold and became a part of things," said John Modisett, Sandy's brother. "She was very proud of North Dakota and her heritage."

The Memorial Scholarship:

NDRPA will award two monetary scholarships of up to \$1,000 each during the 2018-2019 academic year. Each scholarship will also include free registration and assistance with some travel expenses to attend the 2018 NDRPA State Conference and a one-year membership in NDRPA. Selection of recipients will be based on demonstrated academic achievement and professional commitment.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be enrolled as a full-time sophomore, junior or senior student at a North Dakota college or university in fall 2018.
- Be enrolled in a recreation/leisure/natural resource/tourism service/sport management curriculum as a major area of study.
- Preference will be given to students who are members of NDRPA at the time of application.

Application Deadline:

Completed applications must be received by April 1, 2018. Successful candidates will be invited to attend the NDRPA State Conference & Awards Banquet September 11-13 in Dickinson, N.D., where they will be awarded their scholarships.
