NDRPA was actively engaged in the 2019 **State Legislative Session**. The association worked successfully to pass a number of bills, including increasing the park district bid threshold, allowing approval of park district general obligation bonds with a protest period, and ensuring park districts have the ability to protest special assessments approved by other political subdivisions. NDRPA filled Memorial Hall with exhibits showcasing the value and benefits of parks and recreation in March during **Parks Day at the Capitol**, held in partnership with the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department (NDPRD).




NDRPA continued its publications, the monthly electronic *NDRPA eUpdate* and the quarterly magazine *FOCUS*.
