Terry Wallace, superintendent of parks and recreation in Devils Lake, was the 23rd inductee into the NDRPA Hall of Fame.

Wallace earned a degree in business administration and business education from the University of North Dakota. He joined the Devils Lake Park District as recreation supervisor and then became superintendent of parks and recreation in 1992.

Wallace has led many efforts in the Devils Lake community to upgrade its parks and added two new parks. By hosting hundreds of tournaments and events, the Devils Lake Park District has had a significant local and state impact on the quality of life for fellow North Dakotans and out-of-state visitors.

He has been actively engaged in many sports associations, including the North Dakota Amateur Softball Association and the North Dakota Amateur Hockey Association, North Dakota Babe Ruth, the Devils Lake Blue Line Club, the North Dakota Officials' Association, and the Devils Lake Officials' Association. Wallace is also a member of the Devils Lake Kiwanis Club, Elks, and Knights of Columbus.

Terry was recognized as the 2013-2014 North Dakota High School Activities Association Girls' Basketball Official of the Year. In 2014, he was awarded the NDRPA Distinguished Professional Award, and, in 2018, he was inducted into both the North Dakota Officials' Association Hall of Fame and the North Dakota Babe Ruth Hall of Fame.

Since becoming a NDRPA member in 1991, Wallace has served on numerous committees and held several leadership roles, including secretary, FOCUS editor, treasurer, and president. He has been the tournament manager of NDRPA-sponsored state tournaments and events and served as North Dakota's Hershey's Track Coordinator for 11 years.

All NDRPA Hall of Fame members are recognized with plaques at the North Dakota Sports Hall of Fame in the Jamestown Civic Center.
