David Klundt is the 31st individual inducted into the NDRPA Hall of Fame.

Klundt is the aquatics and recreation manager for the Fargo Park District, the latest in a long line of jobs he has held since joining the district after graduation from North Dakota State University in 1990.

Klundt has been, and remains, active in the NDRPA, serving since 2020 as a member of the Awards Committee. He previously served on the board of directors in 1997-98 and 2003-2007; was president in 1996-97 and 2002-03; and treasurer in 1992-1994. In 2005, he was honored with the NDRPA Fellow Award, now known as the Distinguished Professional Award.

One of Klundt's proudest achievements was his involvement in the creation of an executive director position for NDRPA, a position that strengthened an already strong organization and ensured its continued growth and success. He also takes great pride in being able to mentor and promote young staff members throughout his career.

Klundt is a founding member of the Fargo Area Aquatics Professionals organization, which supports the growth and development of aquatics programs and services in the community. He played a key role in transforming several outdated traditional pools into modern recreational aquatic facilities while ensuring the highest standards of aquatic safety.

In his personal life, Klundt has been deeply involved in youth sports. He served as a state commissioner for both Babe Ruth and Cal Ripken Baseball and spent 22 years as a district commissioner.

Klundt also served as a board member for the North Dakota Officials Association, helping to improve officiating standards across the state. He was inducted into the North Dakota Officials Association Hall of Fame in March 2025.

All NDRPA Hall of Fame members are recognized with plaques at the North Dakota Sports Hall of Fame in the Jamestown Civic Center.
